Course Overview:

Students will review the importance of screencasting as an everyday learning tool. Educational research and literature will be explored as well as practical application of screencasting. Several screencasting tools will be examined and students will be expected to create multiple screencasts that apply to various learning objectives.

Course Description:

Explore and discover how to create screencasts for your classroom. A screencast can be a powerful educational tool to help with remediation, differentiation, independent learning, and hybrid learning stations. Screencasts are also a useful supplement for students when a teacher cannot be in the classroom and can be a critical piece for the flipped classroom. Learn how to create, and implement screencasts as a powerful learning tool in your classroom.

- 1. Discover and review tools that can be used for screencasting
- 2. Review professional articles related to screencasting
- 3. Create multiple screencasts for different learning objectives
- 4. Reflect on how screencasting can improve classroom learning.
