## **Course Description**

This course will use a TED Talk book, online TED Talks and web resources to help the teacher to create effective changes and life choices that go along with a changing world.

### **Course Goal**

By listening, reading and writing the teacher will gain new insights into the need to change, the most effective ways to create change and how to cope with the choices in a changing world.

## **Course Objectives**

The teacher will:

- through web resources recognize the need for change in the school structure.
- read and review the TED Book *Beyond Measure* by Margaret Heffernan.
- compose a philosophically based plan for changing the classroom now and in the future.
- view six TED Talks and relate the content of each talk to change and choice.
- write about how students can be prepared for the choices that need to be made in a changing world.
