Course Description:

If you live in a multicultural community, your classroom may include children of immigrant families who hail from all over the world. Along with their belongings, they brought their own religious beliefs and consequently built places of worship for their community members to attend. For the purpose of attaining firsthand knowledge of your multicultural students' ethnic cultures this class will offer the opportunity for you to attend ethnic festivals and/or tour local historic or contemporary churches, mosques, temples or other ethnic places of worship.

Course Objectives:

Teachers will have the opportunity to learn more about their students' cultural heritage, and religious traditions by:

- 1. Touring the sacred places of worship attended by your ethnically diverse students
- 2. Attending church/temple/mosque special events or festivals
- 3. Writing reflection papers on those experiences

Requirements

- 1. Tour a minimum of four historical or contemporary sacred places of worship that some of your students may be culturally influenced by. You may replace one sacred place tour with a cultural festival or event that may influence your students You are expected to do more than just attend a service or event. Make an appointment to meet with someone who is responsible for the place or event and who can show you around and give you information. You will find that most ethnic cultural organizations will go out of their way to educate the teacher of students who are members of their cultural group.
- 2. Submit one reflection report on each of the four experiences. Include the following.
 - A. Sacred Places
 - Describe your experiences touring each ethnic sacred place and/or service.
 - What interesting facts did you learn?
 - What specific ethnic influences did you observe?
 - What more would you like to learn about the church/temple/mosque? Discuss
 the representative of the sacred place who was helpful in your understanding of
 the services and/or history of the sacred place?
 - Did this glimpse of the ethnic churches and temples increase your understanding of the cultures of the students you teach in your classroom?
 - Include pictures showing you at the ethnic sacred place or service.
 - B. Festival or Celebration
 - Describe the event.
 - What did you learn from attending?
 - Who informed you about the event or festival and in what ways were they helpful?
 - Include pictures showing you at the event or festival.

3. Summarize and evaluation

- Summarize and evaluate your experiences in completing this course.
- What suggestions do you have for improving this self-paced class?
- Would you recommend this class to other teachers?
